DO YOU HAVE A PATIENT WITH MAJOR DEPRESSIVE DISORDER AND/OR ANXIETY DISORDER?



They could be eligible for the ENACT Trial.

The ENACT trial is looking at how a simple genetic test (pharmacogenomics) through a cheek swab can help to tailor antidepressant treatment to your patients.

To be eligible your patient must

- Be aged between 16 and 70 years old; and
- Have a major depressive disorder and/ or an anxiety disorder; and
- Have recently started antidepressants (in last 6 weeks) <u>OR</u> had antidepressant medication/dosage changes (last 3 months).

All study visits are conducted virtually. Patients can be either inpatient or outpatient irrespective of which state they live in.
